The Citizen Police Academy is a 6-week program designed to give the participant a basic knowledge of how your police department operates. Instruction is presented by the police officers. Sessions include both the classroom discussions and hands on demonstration.

Participants learn about the challenges and dangers police officers must be prepared to face each day. Participants also see the equipment and tactics used by the police and can go on patrol as a "Ride Along" to witness firsthand how police officers work.

Persons who apply to enroll in the Citizens Police Academy must be at least 18 years of age and must live or work in the city of Brainerd. Due to the subject matter covered in this program, applicants are subject to a background and criminal history check. Class size is limited.
